Using computer technology and sophisticated modern equipment, diagnostic procedures allow health care professionals to view organs, bones and various types of tissue inside the body. These views are captured onto images that can be studied on hard copy photographs or pictures on a monitor.

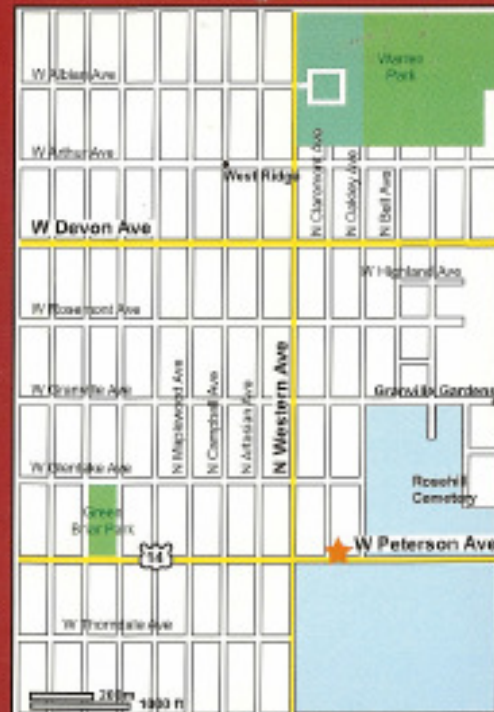

For most procedures, a physician's referral is required. For some tests, a special dye, called a contrast agent, is used to emphasize blood vessels or tissue structure to assist in finding injury or disease. Depending on the type of procedure, this contrast agent is introduced into the body by mouth or injection into a vein. The length of time required to complete an exam varies with the procedure.
